ADULT LEAGUE DESCRIPTIONS

A- DIVISION

The A division is designed for advanced players. The level of play in the A division is generally for the player who desires play in a very competitive program. Players that compete in the A division are not eligible to play in the C division, but can participate in the B and Over-40 divisions if looking for more ice time. Teams must have a minimum of 12 skaters and a goalie on the roster. All players must be 18 years old or older when the league starts. League format is 5 on 5, (3) 13-minute stop time periods, and is non-checking. Each team is permitted (1) 30-second timeout. In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation, we play a 5 minute overtime period with the final minute as stop-time. A best-of-three shootout will follow OT if still tied. This division is very competitive and demands a skilled skater who is familiar with all aspects of the game. Teams are formed and organized by captains.

The B1 division plays on Sunday and Thursday nights.

B-DIVISION

The B division is designed for intermediate/ above average player. The level of play in the B division is generally for the player who has better than average skating skills and knowledge of the game. Teams must have a minimum of 12 skaters and a goalie on the roster. All players must be 18 years old or older when the league starts. League format is 5 on 5, (3) 13-minute stop time periods, and is non-checking. Each team is permitted (1) 30-second timeout. In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation, we play a 5 minute overtime period with the final minute as stop-time. A best-of-three shootout will follow OT if still tied. Teams are formed and organized by captains. The B2 division plays on Wednesday nights.

C-DIVISION

The C division is designed for novice/ average players. The level of play in the C division is generally for players that have less than average skating skills and for teams not of a serious competitive nature. Teams and players are monitored to ensure fairness. The league reserves the right to remove any players that are deemed to be too advanced for this level. Teams must have a minimum of 12 skaters and a goalie on the roster. All players must be 18 years old or older when the league starts. League format is 5 on 5, (3) 13-minute stop time periods, and is non-checking. Each team is permitted (1) 30-second timeout. In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation, we play a 5 minute overtime period with the final minute as stop-time. A best-of-three shootout will follow OT if still tied. Teams are formed and organized by captains. The C division plays on Monday and Tuesday nights.

Over-40 DIVISION

The Over-40 division is designed for all levels of play. The 40+ division is for players aged 40 and over. The only exception is for goalies, who may be 30+ years old. Players may compete in any other division at Glacier Ice. This league is drafted each and every season to promote parity and balance. Players are encouraged to register early to guarantee placement. At the start of every season, Glacier Ice conducts an evaluation for new players. Teams may have up to 13 skaters and a goalie on the roster and the league reserves the right to adjust the teams to maintain balance. League format is 5 on 5, (3) 13-minute stop time periods, and is non-checking. Each team is permitted (1) 30-second timeout. In the event of a tie score at the end of regulation, we play a 5 minute overtime period with the final minute as stop-time. A best-of-three shootout will follow OT if still tied. The Over-40 division plays on Sunday nights.
