MINI-MITE (ages 7 and under)

Our Mini-Mite Program is designed to introduce the game of ice hockey to beginners. The emphasis in this program is skill development and fun. All participants will receive a mixture of practice and cross-ice games. No score or standings will be kept. This program will be offered once per week, so additional practice and development is strongly encouraged. This program will help prepare players for Mite 8u League.

- Players born in 2002 and younger
 - USA Hockey Cross-Ice Format
 - Full gear is required
 - 10-Week Sessions (session schedule will be provided)
 - MML meets every Saturday at 9:40am-10:40am (see posted schedule)
 - Price: \$175 per session

MITE – SQUIRT LEAGUE (ages 6-10)

Our recreational Mite and Squirt leagues will further the development and fun for your player. All teams will have a mixture of practices and games from seasons' start through completion (February – May). **All players** must attend a player evaluation on Friday, February 5, 2010 (see schedule below). All players must be registered for the league before evaluations start. Completed registration includes: Glacier Youth Hockey Registration Form completely filled-out, full payment, and USA Hockey registration for 2009-2010. Players that are 6-7 years old and not ready to compete at the mite level will be placed in the Mini-Mite League.

- Players born in 2001 or younger are Mites
 - Players born in 1999 or 2000 are Squirts
 - 1 Evaluation Skate on February 5: Mites at 5:10pm, Squirts at 6:20pm
 - 16 one-hour team practices during season
 - 14 games, plus playoffs
 - Players will be notified by Wednesday, February 17th as to team placement and schedule.

ADVANCED 4ON4 YOUTH LEAGUE

Starting this Spring, Glacier Ice is offering an alternative program for advanced players and teams. This program is geared for travel players that are looking for a higher level and more challenging house league. Games will be played 4on4 to allow players more open ice, which is great for skill development and conditioning. The league will accept team registrations only for the Squirt through Bantam Divisions. We do not guarantee league balance and recommend AA level teams to play up a division if possible. All teams should consist of a USAH certified head coach, 10-12 skaters, and a goalie. Teams will have a mixture of practices and games from seasons' start through completion (March – May). Completed registration includes: A team roster, players names, jersey numbers, sizes and team payment in full. All players must fill out the Glacier Youth Registration Form and include their USA Hockey ID.

ATTENTION PARENTS AND PLAYERS

SAHOF has mandated that ALL member organizations participate in the USA Hockey Online Registration Procedure. You **MUST** purchase your skater's USA Hockey Membership online for the 2009-10 season. The total amount is \$38, of which \$30 goes to USA Hockey and \$8 to SAHOF (Statewide Amateur Hockey of Florida). Players under the age of six are no cost, but must be registered.

- Confirm you are 18 years of age or older by clicking "Continue"
- Select the link for the 2009-2010 Season
- Select whom you are registering (Self / Child / Adult) and click "Continue"
- Complete the personal information
- You will need to read the waiver, select the "I Accept" box, enter your initials, then click "Continue"
- Review the information and either edit or click "Continue"
- Complete the credit card information (if necessary) and click "Continue"
